Part 8: Eunuchs

Scripture Readings:

- Matthew 19:8-12
- 1 Corinthians 7:7-8, 25-26, 38, 40
- 1 Corinthians 7:32-35
- Isaiah 56:3-5
- Isaiah 54:1-3
- Revelation 14:1-4 AMP

1Then I looked, and this is what I saw: the Lamb stood [firmly established] on Mount Zion, and with Him a hundred and forty-four thousand who had His name and His Father's name inscribed on their foreheads [signifying God's own possession]. 2And I heard a voice from heaven, like the sound of great waters and like the rumbling of mighty thunder; and the voice that I heard [seemed like music and] was like the sound of harpists playing on their harps. 3And they sang a new song before the throne [of God] and before the four living creatures and the elders; and no one could learn the song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who had been purchased (ransomed, redeemed) from the earth. 4These are the ones who have not been defiled [by relations] with women, for they are celibate. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These have been purchased and redeemed from among men [of Israel] as the first fruits [sanctified and set apart for special service] for God and the Lamb. 5No lie was found in their mouth, for they are blameless (spotless, untainted, beyond reproach).

Prayers for:

- People to hear and accept the call to be eunuchs.
- The Lord to give the help and gifts necessary to those He's ordained to be eunuchs.
- People to stop putting marriage before/above God's Kingdom.
- More people to see the benefit and glory in total sacrifice.
- God's Kingdom to be about what we can do for Him and not only what He can do for us.
- The single people to honor God's will for their lives.
- The single people to honor God's timeline for their lives.
- The eunuchs to see the beauty in their call to singleness.
- More people to permanently surrender their total self, marital status included, to God.
- Your children to be strong and surrendered enough to joyfully accept the call to be a eunuch, whether seasonally or permanently.
