Part 9: Sex

Biblical Purposes For Sex:

- Genesis 1:28, 4:1-2- To be fruitful and fill the earth with people.
- 2 Samuel 12:24, Genesis 18:12- To bring comfort and pleasure.
- Ruth 4:13-14, 17- To raise up and continue a godly legacy in the earth.
- Genesis 15:1-5- To pour out rewards on His servant's descendants.
- Psalm 127:3- To reward His servants.
- Proverbs 17:6- To bring and display glory in the family.
- Proverbs 5:15-19- For husbands and wives to share special love and blessings with each other.

Questions:

- What have you learned in this lesson?
 - Reproductive system, gender, virginity, marriage, where babies come from, what sex is, etc.
- Has these new things changed your views on marriage?
- Now, what do you think about marriage?
- Right now you are growing into a man/woman; and it is important for you to know and understand your body. You'll be learning more about your body and sex.
- Have you ever heard of sex talked about in a disrespectful or ungodly way?

I understand that some children are not conceived between a husband and wife, and may have questions. Please let them know that they are still a blessing and a gift, and are very loved. You can tell them the way they were conceived was not the way God intended and that (if this is the truth) you didn't know any better. Assure them that God loves them and has a very special plan for them. Encourage them to change the lineage by waiting for marriage and producing children's God's way, and making Spirit led choices concerning who they date and marry.



We've learned a lot about what sex is, and why God created it. For the next week, take at least five minutes and pray with your child(ren) about sex. Below are some points to include.

Prayers for:

- Sex to be honored as God's special creation for husbands and wives.
- Sex to be understood from a biblical context.
- Sex to be treated with respect and discretion.
- Husbands and wives to enjoy a healthy sexual relationship with each other.
- More children to be born to righteous people.
- For God's people to have the faith needed to continue to be fruitful and multiply.
- Husbands and wives to understand how to love each other in a special way.
- People to maintain their purity until they are married.
- Your children to stay virgins and sexually pure as they grow into men and women.

Being so open about sex may feel a bit strange. Yet, it takes the curiosity out of the topic and enables our children to grow with a healthy understanding and perspective of their bodies and how to handle themselves. Being open about sex is not about flaunting sexual behaviors, it is about being able to view sex as something God created as sacred and not what the world/satan has made it out to be. Many children today are learning about sex through pornography, peers, social media, etc. Sex is God's creation and we are taking the initiative to teach our Christian children sex from a biblical worldview.

Key Structures of External Female Reproductive System:

- Mons Pubis: A fatty tissue pad over the pubic symphysis, typically covered in hair after puberty.
- Labia Majora (Outer Lips): Large, fleshy folds of skin that protect the other external organs.
- Labia Minora (Inner Lips): Smaller, delicate folds of skin located inside the labia majora that surround the vestibule
- Clitoris: A highly sensitive, erectile organ located at the top of the labia minora, covered by a hood.
- Vulvar Vestibule: The area enclosed by the labia minora, containing the openings for the urethra and vagina.
- Urethral Opening (Meatus): The opening through which urine exits the body, located below the clitoris.
- Vaginal Opening (Orifice): The entrance to the vagina, which may be partially covered by the hymen.
- Bartholin's Glands: Located on either side of the vaginal opening, these secrete fluid for lubrication.
- Perineum: The area between the vulva and the anus.
